LEARNING OBJECTIVES

Structure - in the form of limits, boundaries, routines, and roles - diminishes anxiety. Anxiety fuels conflict. Conflict harms kids. Therefore, structure can serve children's needs. This training and education helps participants better structure their role in the family law process to the benefit of all. Upon completion of this session, attendees will be able to:

1. **Identify** the limits, boundaries, routines, and roles built into their work;
2. **Demonstrate** how these structures are defined in the parenting plan that they are crafting, the family therapy that they are facilitating, the co-parenting intervention that they're conducting, or the child custody evaluation that they are planning;
3. **Assess** the impact should they fail to follow through with consequences or enforce the boundaries that distinguish one home from another, personal from professional;
4. **Implement** efforts to address the well-intended effort to wear too many professional hats that are likely to do more harm to all involved -including the participant- than good;
5. **Identify** why limits, boundaries, routines, and roles are essential to not only effective family law practice but also to healthy self-care.
